What is Bookshare

Bookshare is an ebook library that makes reading easier. Individuals with dyslexia, blindness, physical disabilities, and other reading barriers can customize their reading experience in ways that work for them. Members can listen to books read aloud, follow along with highlighted text, read in braille or large font, and more.

The Bookshare library has over 930,000 titles, giving members access to virtually any book they need for school, career, or leisure reading. Students can easily access textbooks, educational materials, awardwinning novels, New York Times best sellers, newspapers and periodicals, and more on virtually any device and platform.

Bookshare is FREE for all qualified U.S. students of any age.

How Can Bookshare Help Job Corps?

To meet the growing need to provide flexible "real time" accommodations and support for students with print disabilities in all settings (e.g., academic, career technical, employment, independent living, etc.), Bookshare provides free technology-based tools and resources so qualified students can access printed materials anytime and anywhere.

Bookshare's vast collection includes a dedicated Job Corps' library with many commonly used textbooks, study guides and career resources such as TABE Fundamentals for Reading and Math, GED Prep, TASC Prep, career technical books for Job Corps Health Occupations, Homeland Security, Welding, Retail, Career Transition, and many others.
