SUBJECT: Center Scheduling Incoming Cohorts for Full-time Residential
Participation

Effective immediately, centers may begin scheduling incoming cohorts of students (either current students in distance learning, students in ASWR status who are being reinstated and returned, or virtually-enrolled students who have completed 60 days of virtual CPP) to arrive at the center for full-time residential participation every Tuesday. Job Corps will no longer mandate a fixed biweekly cohort arrival date; however, it will continue to provide a weekly center status update (i.e., approved for round, active, pause) identifying centers that may safely arrive students the following Tuesday. Centers must continue to ensure that there is adequate quarantine and isolation space when determining the size or scheduling of incoming cohorts as required by PIN 20-08 and 20-20. Centers are not required to arrive students weekly if they do not have sufficient quarantine and/or isolation space, or if other logistical concerns with meeting the requirements of PIN 20-08 and 20-20 preclude the arrival of a new cohort.
