The Job Corps National Office is committed to supporting students and staff in promoting and sustaining a positive center culture nationwide. To assist in this effort, a variety of resources, tools and trainings have been developed and made available in a centralized location on the Job Corps Community website. *Cultural Awareness Resources*. Job Corps staff are encouraged to participate in a multi-module training series designed to help build a welcoming center culture for all students from different cultural backgrounds, including refugees. Training materials are provided for all center staff, admissions staff, and staff responsible for facilitating student training and student cultural events.

Sexual Misconduct Prevention Curriculum (Consent). Job Corps is implementing an evidence-based training program designed to prevent sexual misconduct and promote consent for safe center living. This curriculum was designed specifically for Job Corps centers by experts in the field of sexual misconduct prevention. This training supports policy requirements to prepare staff and students in creating a positive center culture. All students are expected to receive the training when they arrive on-center during their Career Preparation Period to provide instruction and support. Operators will prepare centers to implement these new training resources, and are encouraged to identify staff to administer the sexual misconduct prevention workshops and trainings featured in this curriculum.
