SUBJECT:	Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Emergency Preparedness

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To encourage Job Corps centers to learn more about the FEMA National Preparedness Coalition, in preparation for National Preparedness Month, which will be observed in September 2012.
- 2. <u>Background</u>. The National Incident Management System defines preparedness as "a continuous cycle of planning, organizing, training, equipping, exercising, evaluating, and taking corrective action in an effort to ensure effective coordination during incident response." This "preparedness cycle" is one element of a broader National Preparedness System to prevent, respond to, recover from, and mitigate impact of natural disasters, acts of terrorism, and other man-made disasters.

The Department of Homeland Security/FEMA supports preparedness by developing policies, ensuring adequate plans are in place and are validated, defining necessary capabilities required to address threats, providing resources and technical assistance to jurisdictions, and integrating and synchronizing preparedness efforts throughout the nation.
